Technical Surveillance Sciences, Inc. (TSS) is pleased to announce that under the sponsorship of the Westminster Police Department we will be conducting our 40 plus hour Physical Surveillance Operations (AT/FP) program in Westminster, and the surrounding areas. The training will be conducted from Monday, June 5th thru Friday, June 9th, 2017.

ENROLLMENT RESTRICTED: Only individuals who are active-duty law enforcement officers, prosecutors, investigators or agents; or, active-duty members of the U.S. military, and civilian Department of Defense (DOD), or U.S. intelligence community employees will be accepted for enrollment in our programs. Non-sworn, civilian employees, technicians, or other professionals who are employed in a direct operational support role; or members of the National Guard & Reserves may also attend restricted enrollment programs, providing such training is required in order to perform their government, or U.S. military, DOD, or intelligence related duties.



COURSE DESCRIPTION: The Physical Surveillance Operations course offered by TSS is a 40 plus hour Program of Instruction (POI) which teaches, and exposes the attendee to the basic principles and techniques used to conduct covert visual surveillance of persons, places and things.



Specific instruction is provided on how to plan a surveillance operation; personnel selection, assignment and training; formation of surveillance teams; special equipment requirements (team & individual), and how to develop secure “working” maps of the surveillance areas. Formal instruction along with a series of carefully structured, progressively more complex practical exercises (PRACTEX) will expose the student to the

various methods used to conduct foot, stationary, and mobile vehicular surveillance operations.

In addition each student will also be taught how to develop secure surveillance codes when using non-secure two-way radios or cell/sat phones. They will also be taught how to use technical devices and systems to enhance the overall surveillance operation.

Special operational techniques will teach each attendee how to use cameras and visual enhancement devices discreetly; how to avoid being compromised; how to detect typical agent streetcraft activities; cover stories – cover for status and action; how to prepare surveillance notes, logs and reports, and how to prepare for unexpected situations.



Each student will be taught the principles of loose and close surveillances as well as the differences between progressive, protective and saturation surveillance operations. Limited instruction will be given to at least expose the attendees to the risks presented if the target of the surveillance utilizes counter-surveillance/surveillance detection techniques.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT: Each student's home agency is responsible for providing the attendee(s) with a vehicle & fuel necessary for use during the Practical Exercise portion of this program. As well as a minimal amount of money to be utilized as "cover stop" funds for possible entrance fees to any public facilities that may be utilized for training purposes.

TSS will provide the necessary communications equipment and Sony HandyCam DVR's for the students use during training.
